New class for Dairy Male kids

Entries are welcome from both dairy and pygmy herds,

The Cornwall Goatkeepers Association offer a special medallion for best in show for both dairy and pygmy classes, and rosettes for 1st - 4th places in the various classes, and also special rosettes for best and reserve, in show. All dairy entries to be female only, except male kids, and are to be CAE neg. and from whole herd tested negative herds. **Certificates with entries please,** and they will be returned to you on day of show, or if required before, please enclose a SAE. Pygmy goats to be judged under the rules of the Pygmy Goat Club. No pregnant goats to be entered.

Classes will be categorised at secretary's discretion, according to breed and number of entries, and if 3 or more goats of a dairy breed, they will be in a separate class.

- CLASSES**
- 1 Male kids over 2 months & under 1 year (D & P)
 - 2 Pygmy Bucklings Over 1 Year & Under 2 Years
 - 3 Pygmy Adult Males Over 2 Years
 - 4 Female kids over 2 months & under 1 year (D & P)
 - 5 Goatlings over 1 year & under 2 years
(must not have kidded D & P)
 - 6 Dairy Milkers/Adult Female Pygmies 2 years & over (D & P)
 - 7 Veteran pygmy female over 7 years
 - 8 Dam & Daughter (counts as one entry D & P)
 - 9 Dam & male progeny (counts as one entry D & P)
 - 10 Pygmy Sire & Progeny (one entry) min 2 progeny
 - 11 Pygmy Wethers/Pet female (Not entered in Breed Class)
 - 12 Junior Handlers (entries on the day)

NB:entries for classes 8,9 &10 must be entered in the appropriate breed class

To all members, this is the first show of the season, and is an ideal time to prepare your goats for the 2017 season, please enter so Brian, a good supporter of the CGA , will have a good selection of goats to judge.

Note the show will be held on hard standing

Please note if the weather or conditions are not suitable for holding the show outdoors, we will hold the show indoors utilising undercover part of Mays Country Store

Penning is not available, so please bring your own

Directions

The show venue is located 3 miles from St Austell just off the A390 Truro road. From A30 Innis Downs junction, take A391 through Bugle and Stenalees, to junction with A390 at Holmbush, turn right, and follow A390 round St Austell towards Truro, passing Asda and Macdonalds, after this junction continue for approx 3 miles, and just past town sign for Hewaswater, turn right signposted to Coombe (and Mays store) and continue for approx.25 yards and entrance to Mays Country Store is on the left.

If travelling from Plymouth take A38 to Dobwalls and then A390 to St Austell Travelling from West Cornwall via Truro, take A390 for St Austell to Hewaswater turn left opposite Toms garage.

Venue will be signposted from the A390 at Hewaswater

Tea and coffee will be available for a small charge of 20p per cup or 50p for as many refills as you wish.
